# Homework

For homework, we are putting an exciting change in place this year; the only homework the children will receive will be spellings, reading and Times Table Rockstars. We will expect the children to read at least 5 times a week - the length of time they read for will depend on you - we understand that some days you will have less time than others. Obviously, the more time given to reading, the more the children will benefit. Your child can read independently for most of those sessions, but please try to listen to your child at least once a week and discuss with them what they have read as often as possible. Spellings will be sent home once a week, which the children will be tested on, please see your class letter for details of days. A play on Times Tables Rockstars once or twice a week will be hugely helpful for learning times tables, which is an invaluable skill set.
