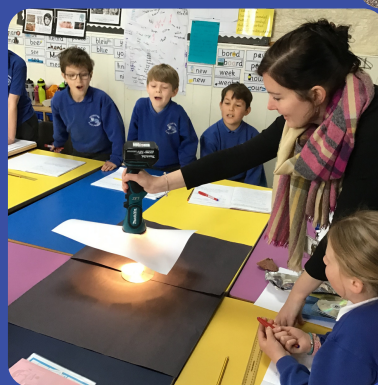
Early Morning Club
