

PE and Sport Premium 2016-2017

At the Raleigh Federation, we have received a total of £16,715 for the year 2016-2017 to spend across both Drake's C of E School and Otterton C of E School.

This money is being spend as follows:-

£5,100 approximately towards specialist PE teaching by Catherine Tribble

£5,100 approximately towards specialist PE teaching by Sally Leat

£3,600 contribution towards EALC to provide fixtures and staff training

£2,800 approximately for a variety of in school-time events and after-school clubs.

The impact of this provision on participation and attainment is:-

"New" clubs have been offered e.g. Fencing, Street Surfing.

These improvements are sustainable because:-

Co-ordinator Catherine Tribble and co-ordinator & PE specialist Sally Leat are permanent members of staff with dedicated co-ordination time.

Part of the funding has been dedicated to staff training.

PTFA and OCESA continue to subsidise after-school clubs.
